

EXCURSION TO STOCKHOLM



Stockholm Business and Innovation Visit

In May 2025, the BMS visiting group explored Stockholm's dynamic business and urban development landscape through a series of engaging sessions. The visit began with a guided walking tour of Stockholm's historic Old Town, led by a local BMS alumnus, providing a vibrant introduction to the city.

Participants then engaged with Stockholm Business Region AB, the city's official business and destination development agency, learning about Stockholm's innovative, sustainable, and creative business environment. The group also visited the Ports of Stockholm at Frihamnen, gaining valuable insights into the crucial role of maritime logistics and infrastructure in regional development.

Further sessions included an exploration of the Royal Seaport's ambitious urban development projects, highlighting Stockholm's commitment to sustainable city planning. The visit concluded with a presentation at the Stockholm Resilience Centre by Rich Wilson, CEO of the democratic innovation centre Iswe, who introduced the UN Global Citizens' Assembly - a pioneering initiative to enhance global governance through broad citizen participation ahead of major international climate conferences.

This immersive program offered students a comprehensive view of Stockholm's regional business, urban innovation, and global democratic initiatives.
