

From September 2–7, 2025, the Expanded Summer School offers an intensive learning experience at the School of Informatics, Communications and Media in Hagenberg and Linz.

Held alongside the **Expanded Conference** during the **Ars Electronica Festival**, the program is a platform for emerging scholars and practitioners. It starts with a workshop in Hagenberg, then continues in Linz with conference and festival activities—offering both focused skill development and broad exposure to digital and interactive art.

The 2025 theme, "Evaluating Games", explores how users interact with games and interactive environments—crucial in game development, HCl, and Digital Arts. The program links practical evaluation techniques with broader topics like UX, player engagement, and behavioral analysis in digital performance.

Participants deepen their knowledge, explore Upper Austria's culture, meet international peers and experts, and expand their networks. Completion awards **3 ECTS credits**, adding academic value to a rich practical experience.

The program starts on **September 2** with a full-day workshop on game evaluation, combining theory and practice. It features expert presentations, followed by playtesting sessions where participants apply the methods discussed.
