



Mistral Scholarship Program

What is the Mistral Scholarship?

A scholarship program intended for international students of an excellent level enrolled in a Higher Education Institution outside France and who:

- wish to pursue their studies at Avignon University in order to obtain a Master's Degree
- would be interested in undertaking post-graduate research at our university

What are the benefits?

- 6000€ for each year of the Master (second year of scholarship is renewable according to program criteria)
- Mistral scholarship students are exempt from registration fees
- possibility to book an accommodation, via the International Relations Office of Avignon University, in a university residence

Main criteria:

- to be enrolled in Higher Education Institution outside France when applying (applicants enrolled in Avignon University's partner Institutions will be prioritised) or not to have interrupted their studies for more than an academic year
- to have a very good academic record and meet the academic and linguistic criteria established by the faculty of the Master's Degree at Avignon University
- French B2 minimum, C1 for some Master's Degree
- to be under 28 years old on the 31th of December 2025
- not to have a residence in France

Application campaign 2025-26: from 5th February to 24th March 2025.
