

Registration and quarantine for university members if infection with the coronavirus is suspected

Symptoms of the disease if you have symptoms such as fever, cough, sore throat, rhinitis, diarrhoea, breathing, loss of smell and taste problems,	1
Contact with infected persons if you have had personal contact within the past 14 days with a person with whom SARS-CoV-2 has been detected	2
Return from abroad (CoronaEinreiseVO) If you enter the Federal Republic of Germany from abroad after a stay,	3
Positive PCR test (§ 1a para. 8 no. 1 Corona-LVO) If a test by means of nucleic acid detection (PCR, PoC-PCR or other methods of nucleic acid amplification technology) proves an infection with the SARS-CoV-2,	4
Positive rapid test or self-test (§ 1a para. 8 no. 2 Corona-LVO) If an antigen test (rapid test or self-test) detects infection with SARS-CoV-2,	5



you are obliged,

- to report your case electronically at coronameldung@hochschule-stralsund.de, stating the case number, and to leave the campus and enter 14-day domestic quarantine in cases 2, 3, 4, and 5. In the case of entry without prior stay in a virus variant area, a duration of 10 days applies.
(For termination of quarantine see § 4 CoronaEinreiseVO and § 1a para. 8 Corona-LVO M-V, for exceptions from quarantine after contact see also general decree segregation and contact person management of the district V-R).
- to report immediately to the health office in cases 2, 3, 4 and 5; in case 3 to report their entry at www.einreiseanmeldung.de
- in cases 3 and 5 to be tested for SARS-CoV-2 infection. The test result of the PCR test must already be available upon entry. In case of entry from abroad without previous stay in virus variant areas, proof of recovery or proof of vaccination is sufficient.
