

## Notification obligation and quarantine in case of suspected infection with the coronavirus

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he Minist ecklenbu	<b>Contact with infected persons</b> f you have had personal contact within the past 14 days with a person who has been diagnosed with SARS-CoV-2	2
if if	<b>Return from risk areas - International</b> f you enter the country within the last 14 days from an area which is currently classified as a risk area by the Robert Koch Institute	3
Recommen Science and I	<b>Return from particularly affected areas - National</b> f you come back within the last 14 days from an area that is currently classified as "particularly affected" by the Robert Koch Institute	4

Reasonable suspicion according to Robert Koch Institute

**Return from risk areas and symptoms of disease** if you enter the country within the last 14 days from an area which is currently classified as a risk area by the Robert Koch Institute and have symptoms

**Contact with infected persons and symptoms** if you have had personal contact within the past 14 days with a person who has been diagnosed with SARS-CoV-2 and has symptoms

- 1. You are obliged to contact your doctor by telephone. There you will receive information on the further course of treatment.
- You are obliged to go into 14day domestic quarantine. Returning to campus is only possible if you present a negative test for the SARS CoV 2 virus or freedom from symptoms.
