

**Notice**  
from 25.03. to 27.05.2026

**1. General Information**

The election period of the elected representatives in the boards of the university self-administration will end within a short period of time. According to the regulations of the State Higher Education Act M-V (LHG M-V) and our election regulations, new elections must therefore be held at the university.

The elections for the Student Parliament (StuPa) and the faculty student councils will be combined with these board elections upon their request.

The following seats are to be filled in the individual committees:

\* The elected Senate members are also members of the Extended Senate.

The legal basis for the elections is the State Higher Education Act M-V in the new version of 25.01.2011 with the last amendment of 21.06.2021, the University's Bylaws of 01.03.2017 and the Election Regulations of 08.01.2021.

The public counting of the votes and the determination of the election result will take place on the same day from 3.00 pm in the polling station.

**2. Publications**

All election announcements and notifications will be published on the official notice board at the election office and online (e-HOST – Gremien und Querschnittsthemen, Gremienwahlen, and on Moodle – Gremien & Vertretungen, Gremienwahlen).

### **3. Active and Passive Right to Vote**

Only those who are entered in the electoral roll may vote (active right to vote).

Only those who are entered in the electoral roll by the deadline for submitting nominations (see point 5) are eligible to run for office (passive voting right).

The electoral registers will be available at the electoral office from 25.03.2026 and can be viewed there, as can the legal basis for the election.

Objections to the accuracy of the electoral roll can be made in writing to the electoral officer by any university member entitled to vote until 20.05.2026, 12.00 noon.

### **4. Postal Vote**

Please observe the possibility of postal voting. Eligible voters who are unable to cast their vote in person on election day can make use of the postal voting option. Applications for postal votes must be submitted informally but in writing to the electoral office by no later than 18.05.2026, 12.00 noon. This can be done by email to [kanzlersekretariat@hochschule-stralsund.de](mailto:kanzlersekretariat@hochschule-stralsund.de) or by internal post. A sample of what information the postal vote application should contain is available at e-HOST – Gremien und Querschnittsthemen, Gremienwahlen.

Further information on postal voting can be obtained from the election officer.

### **5. Election Proposals**

All eligible voters are hereby requested to submit election proposals. The nominations must be submitted in the correct form in accordance with the provisions of the election regulations, separately for each board to be elected and only on the official forms, stating "Name of the list". The forms are available at the election office (House 1, Room 205) during opening hours on Monday from 10:00 - 12:00 and from 14:00 – 15:00, Wednesday from 14:00 - 15:00 and on Thursday from 10:00 - 12:00 and 13:00 - 15:00. Appointments outside these times can be made by e-mail to [kanzlersekretariat@hochschule-stralsund.de](mailto:kanzlersekretariat@hochschule-stralsund.de), or by telephone on 03831 45-6502. In addition, the forms can be downloaded from the Internet (Gremienwahlen bei e-HOST – Gremien und Querschnittsthemen, Gremienwahlen).

The nominations must be submitted by April 09, 2026, 12.00 noon in paper form to the electoral office by a nominator. Please also note the opening hours of the electoral office or make an appointment. Make sure that you adhere to the deadlines. Election proposals that are not submitted on time and in the correct form are invalid.

Please note that if you belong to more than one group or faculty, you can choose the group or faculty for exercising your right to vote by making a declaration within the deadline for submitting nominations (Section 2 (6) WO).

Each university member may only be named on one nomination for the election of the relevant body (Section 10 (2) No. 8). In the case of a separate declaration of consent by the candidate, it must be clearly recognizable for which election proposal (state the name of the election proposal) the declaration applies.

According to Section 12 (2) of the election regulations, individual nominations must be signed by at least one authorized nominee. A contact person for queries, information etc. must be specified for each election proposal (individual or list proposal). Each university member may only sign as a nominator on one election proposal of the respective body to be elected for the election of the respective collegial body in his/her group.

## **6. Announcement of the Election**

The preliminary election announcement will be made on April 9, 2025 at the latest.

## **7. Other Information**
