

GET READY! – REMAINING PLACES IN THE STUDY PREPARATION COURSE AT THE HOST

In September 2019, the new study preparation course for foreign prospective students starts at the University of Applied Sciences Stralsund (HOST). In two semesters, the course prepares students specifically for engineering and economics courses. Since the most important prerequisite for successful studies in Germany is the required language level of the students, the German intensive course is at the centre of the programme.

The course mainly comprises an intensive general German course with TestDaF training at the target level of GER B2.2. The preparatory year also includes the modules Study Organisation and Study Practice as well as the module Technical German as a blended learning course, i.e. offline and online lessons. In the last three months, the focus is on study preparation with a focus on technical language in combination with techniques of scientific work. The content of the course is based on the language level GER C1.

The intensive German course and the modules are accompanied by regional research projects on living in Stralsund and studying at the HOST, as well as an accompanying programme which includes a technical tutorial with attendance of a lecture, intercultural training and support as well as placement tests and intermediate examinations. In addition, there is an accompanying excursion programme and support for everyday questions, etc.

Participants regularly receive feedback on their performance and can adjust their focus individually and flexibly during the preparation year. In addition, teachers and tutors are always available as contact persons.

- Mechanical Engineering (M.Eng.)
